Admission

The admission process for current academic session will commence from 11th June 2024. Those willing to seek admission, Should duly fill in the application form and submit the following documents alongwith it

- (1) School/College leaving certificate (original and true copy)
- (2) Marksheet of qualifying Examination (original and true copy)
- (3) Character certificate
- (4) Gap certificate (In case of gap period) in education gap affidavit is essential
- (5) Undertaking

Eligibility for Admission (Senior College)

Those who have passed H.S.C. Examination (Arts, Commerce, Science) are eligible to seek admission in (B.A. Part I) 1 st year degree course.

Admission process will be implemented as per national Education policy.

Those who are willing to apply for reserved category quota seats should mention in their application forms. "Application for Reserved category quota seats" Stating clearly their category

(2) The students will abide by the rules and regulations regarding educational session holidays, various examinations fees etc. enacted/issued/imposed by the college authority or the university authority.

(3) The final decision regarding the admission of the student is reserved with the principal of the college.

Fees

EDUCATIONAL CONCESSION /SCHOLARSHIP

1) E.B.C. Concession

The students shall not have to pay tuition fees having parents income below 200000/- Other fees will have to be paid at the time of admission. The admission form should strictly be signed by the father. In case father is not alive, mother should sign the said form. If both are not alive the signature of the nearest relative is mandatory.

2) Merit Scholarships.

- (a) National Merit Scholarship.
- (b) Scholarship to the wards of middle school teachers.
- (c) Government Merit scholarship.
- (d) Loan scholarship.

The schedule for the said Scholarship is displayed on the Notice Board time to time.

3) Scholarship to the wards of freedom fighters

Applications are to be submitted in the prescribed format.

4) Fee Exemption to the wards of middle school Teachers.

The Students eligible to this scholarship will be exempted. Tuition fees and examination fees, other fees will have to be paid at the time of admission.

5) G.O.I.Scholarship

The students belonging to the S.C., S.T., V.J.N.T.,O.B.C., S.B.C. are eligible for this scholarship . Applications forms in the prescribed format should be submitted to the district social welfare office, Akola within the prescribed date.

6) Special Instructions.

1) It is the sole responsibility of the concerned student to submit the scholarship and fees exemption form duly filled in to the office within the last date prescribed.

2) If an annual income of the parents of the students belonging to the schedule castes and tribes is more than 15000/- are not eligible to receive the G.O.I. scholarship but they will be entitled to get the exemption from the state Government.

Note : 1) Application forms will be available in the office, Shri Narsing Arts, Commerce College, Akot. 2) If there is a gap in the education of GOI Scholarship holder students they have to produce a affidavit signed by the magistrate along with the application form showing that during the gap they didn't receive any scholarship either from any college or Government. 3) For latest rules and conditions of eligibility for various awards, scholarships and concession students are advised to contact the concerned Clerk in the office.

Attendance

Minimum 75% classroom attendance for each subject is necessary. Failing to which, the student won't be allowed to appear for the final examination unless he / she produces concrete reason. The names of such students will be struck off from the college. In case, the attendance is below 75% he / she will have to pay the tuition fees.

College Examination

At the end of every academic session, in the last week of February, the annual college examination is conducted. It is mandatory for all students to appear for the examination. Failing to which, the students will have to pay fine as per the norms of examination committee.

College Library

The College has well equipped library having more than 4000 books which include Reference book, Text books and other Journals. A spacious reading hall for the students is also constructed. It is binding on the students to follow the rules and regulations of the library.

Physical Education

The college has a separate department of physical education which conducts various sport activity such as Volleyball, Kabbaddi, Athletics, Power Lifting and Weight Lifting etc. The students are allowed to participate in the university level tournaments strictly on merit basis.

Physical Efficiency Test and P.T. Classes

Two periods per week are compulsory. 75% attendance to P.T. classes is necessary failing to which the students will not be allowed to appear for the examination. Every student will have to undergo physical efficiency test which is conducted in the first week of February every year.

Annual Sports Competitions are held in the month of December every year. The winners are feliciated by giving certificates and mementoes. The students are expected to obey the rules and regulations of the department. Principal's decision is final.

Medical Test

Every student will have to undergo a medical test once in a year. It is compulsory, failing to which the students will have to pay fine.

Students Council Election

Students council is constituted as per the directions from the Director, Students Welfare S.G.B. Amravati University, Amravati.

Incentive Marks

Incentive marks are awarded to the students participating in sports, N.S.S., Blood donation, Youth Festival etc. The Participants have to follow rules and regulations in this regard. The incentive marks can be used for passing.

History Card

This card is given to every student at the time of admission. It is to be preserved till the University Examination, and be submitted in the office obtaining signatures from all the heads of the departments.

Identity Card

Every student should carry I-Card affixing his / her Passport Size Recent Photo on it duly signed by the principal. In case of loss, the I-Card will be issued on payment of Rs. 25/-

Students AID Fund

The needy students are benefitted through this scheme. An application should be submitted in a prescribed format to S.G.B Amravait university as per the rules and regulations.

Teachers-Parents Meet

Every year Teachers-Parents meet is held. This practice helps to resolve the academic and personal problems of the students. It is the best access to form a cordial relationship between the college and the parents.

Creative Writer's Forum

With the intention of promoting creative writing amongst students, creative writer's forum has been established in college wing which publishes respectively at the end of academic session. It also conducts literary meetings and guides and

motivates the budding creative writers.

Incentives to the advanced learners and outstanding sports persons

Students securing highest marks at B.A. I & II Examinations will be considered separately for the award of college Merit Scholarship Sponsored by The Principal and other authorities. Special concession is given to the students of educationally backward communities.

General Instructions

- 1) Principal's decision in all matters will be final and binding to all.
- 2) The behaviour of the student both inside and outside the classroom must be polite and sincere.
- 3) If a student is found guilty in respect of behaviour he / she will be suspended from the institution.
- 4) The neat and careful use of Library Books, Furniture, Fans in the Classroom and Reading room and any other college material in general is necessary otherwise any damage causing to the property of college will be recovered from the students.
- 5) **Every student will have to pay tuition fees of the complete session although he / she desires to leave the college in the mid of the session.**
- 6) The students have an opportunity to change optional subjects with the prior permission of the principal within a month from his admission.
- 7) No argument will be entertained at the library counter with the library staff members.

Special Instructions for parents

- i) The parents are informed that the classroom attendance of their wards for theory periods should be at least 75%. If a ward fails to attend average 75% periods he won't be allowed to appear for the examination, Also he won't receive any concession. Fine for each theory paper will be charged for not attending the college unit test Examination.
- ii) Full paying students shall have to pay 100% of tuition fees at the time of admission.
- iii) Application forms for concession should be submitted in the office at the time of admission.
